However, the teaching of these courses still relies heavily on traditional lectures, making it difficult to stimulate students' interest in learning. According to a survey in the "Research Report on the Teaching of Ideological and Political Courses in Universities (2023)" by Renmin University of China, over 80% of students hope to participate more in discussions, case analyses, and practical activities in ideological and political courses, rather than just passively listening.[6]

3.3 Insufficient Conditions for Practical Teaching in Ideological and Political Courses

Practical teaching in ideological and political courses is crucial for enhancing students' ideological and political qualities as well as their practical abilities. Furthermore, although some universities have established practical teaching bases, due to issues such as inadequate emphasis on practical teaching of ideological and political courses and uneven resource allocation, practical teaching activities becoming merely formalities, and the actual effects of practical teaching are difficult to manifest.

At the same time, the interactivity and participation of the classroom can be enhanced through specific methods such as case teaching and situational simulation.

4.3 Strengthening Practical Teaching to Enhance Students' Comprehensive Qualities

Practical teaching must establish cooperation mechanisms both within and outside the school. According to the "Survey Report on Practical Teaching of Ideological and Political Courses in National Colleges and Universities (2023)", more than 60% of colleges and universities have already implemented practical teaching activities at different levels.
